RESIDENTIAL WASTE



A tag must be affixed on each bag, item or on the top item inside each garbage bag you place at the curb for pick up. The tag must be placed in a manner which is visible by the collection driver and operator.

The Village of Casselman provides an allocation of two (2) bags per week, without stickers. Every additional garbage bag or item, including large articles, appliances, requires a sticker. Bags with leaves may be included in your allocation of two (2) bags per week, without stickers.

Year 2001 stickers are valid and additional stickers can be purchased at our municipal office at a cost of \$2.00 each.



Please place your garbage and recyclable products, as well as your leaves and garden waste at the curb, after 6:00 p.m. the night before the collection, or before 7:00 a.m. on collection day. Garbage cans or containers must not exceed 125 litres or 28 gallons capacity or 40 lbs or 18 kg in total weight, including the weight of the container.



LEAVES AND GARDEN WASTE / COMPOSTING

Leaves and garden waste are picked up on the same day of your regular collection day.

When you choose to send your leaves, plants, shrubs, bushes, grass clippings and garden waste to the garbage, it is better for the environment to put them in a biodegradable plastic bag. These bags may be purchased at your local hardware store.

Branches must be attached in bundles measuring no more than 1.2 m (4 ft long), 30 centimeters (12 inches) in diameter, and not weighing more than 18 kg (40 pounds). Branches must not measure more than 10 cm (3") in diameter. Rocks and earth will not be picked up.



Christmas trees are picked up on the same day of your weekly collection and a sticker is required for pick-up.

Large articles, such as couches and appliances are picked up on the same day as the regular garbage pick-up days, or the day after. Place these articles along the road at the same time as your garbage and do not forget to add a garbage sticker on each item. Appliances containing refrigerant gases such as freezers, refrigerators, air conditioners, dehumidifiers etc...must have the gases removed by a certified technician before the drop off. The technician must affix a valid tag to the unit.



Tires, automobile parts, and propane cylinders are not collected. Residents can bring them, as well as other automobile parts to a dealer. A special collection can be made however, certain costs may accompany such a collection.
