RECYCLING PROGRAM



The Village of Casselman provides a weekly collection of paper, cardboard, and other recyclable products.

Recycling not only reduces the long term costs, but also helps to achieve a better waste management program.

All dwellings, single family homes, row houses and apartment dwellings within the limits of the Village of Casselman, participate in the recycling program.

Small businesses which do not produce more than 5 bags of garbage per week are encouraged to participate and benefit from this program.

METAL CANS:

Rinse cans. Place lids in the can, pinch closed and put loose in the box. Flattened cans save space!
NO pots or scrap metal.

BOTTLES AND JARS:

Clear, coloured bottles and jars **ONLY**. Rinse and place loose in box.
NO drink glasses, ceramic items, windows, mirrors or light bulbs.

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD:

Flatten and tie in bundles no larger than 91 cm x 91 cm x 20 cm or 36" x 36" x 8". **ONLY** broken down and bundled boxes will be collected.
NO waxed boxes or soiled pizza boxes.

NEWSPAPERS AND MAGAZINES:

Stack and tie with string or place in plastic or paper bags in or next to your blue box.
NO soiled newspapers.

BOXBOARD:

Flatten and place inside largest box. Must be clean and void of food. Boxboard includes cereal, shoe and detergent boxes, egg cartons as well as rinsed milk and juice cartons.
NO drink boxes, tissue paper towels or laminated paper.

PLASTIC CONTAINERS:

All plastic with numbers 1 to 7 only in the bottom are accepted. Containers should be rinsed and placed loose in the box.
NO blister or bubble packs, prescription bottles, toys, chairs or stretch wrap.

THE BLUE BOX



A REMINDER:



Blue boxes must be out after 6:00pm the night before the collection, or before 7:00am on the same day of your garbage pick-up.



You have the possibility to use transparent bags or semi-transparent blue bags.



Additional recycling blue boxes can be purchased at the Town Hall office at the cost of \$10.00 (taxes included).

ARTICLES RECYCLABLES

- Sacs en plastique bourrés dans un sac en plastique attaché
- Articles en aluminium (assiettes à tarte, moules à cuisson propres)
- Journaux et circulaires
- Carton ondulé tel que les boîtes d'emballage
- Revues et catalogues
- Annuaires téléphoniques
- Boîtes de carton (céréales, chaussures, détergent, etc.)
- Papier fin tel que le papier à écrire, papier d'ordinateur, blocs- notes, courrier publicitaire et livres; couverture rigide ou souple.
- Boîtes d'oeufs en carton, rouleaux de papier hygiénique, essuie-tout
- Papier d'emballage, cartes de souhaits et sacs d'épicerie en papier
- Boîtes de conserves métalliques pour aliments et breuvages. Rabattre ou placer les couvercles à l'intérieur.
- Contenants en plastique tels que les boissons gazeuses; les contenants de margarine, yogourt; les bouteilles de détergent liquide, shampoing et d'huile à cuisson (bouchons et couvercles enlevés)
- Tout autre produit d'emballage en papier non souillé
- Bouteilles et bocaux de verre ayant contenu des aliments. Rincez et déposez-les-en vrac dans la boîte.

VEUILLEZ NOTER QUE:

- Les petites boîtes peuvent être déposées directement dans le bac.
- Les grands cartons peuvent être aplatis, attachés et placés à côté ou sous la boîte bleue et ne doivent pas dépasser 1m x 1 m (36" x 36").
- Les boîtes en carton ne seront pas ramassées avec les déchets.
- Les journaux et tous les autres papiers recyclables peuvent simplement être empilés dans la boîte bleue. Si vous en avez plusieurs, placez-les dans un sac (en papier de préférence).
- Retirez tout matériel d'emballage en plastique (emballage en plastique recouvrant les cartons de boissons gazeuses)

ARTICLES NON-RECYCLABLES

- Ω Contenants en polystyrène (styrofoam)
- Ω Contenants en aérosol et contenants de peinture
- Ω Boîtes à jus, cartons de lait et de jus
- Ω Articles en céramique, tels qu=assiettes, tasses et poterie.
- Ω Autres produits en verre, tels que les verres à boire, la vitre, les ampoules électriques et les miroirs.
- Ω Autres produits en plastique, comme la vaisselle, les jouets, les contenants de maquillage et les tubes de pâte à calfeutrer.
- Ω Emballages d'aliments surgelés cirés, tels que les boîtes de jus concentrés, les contenants de plats surgelés, les cartons de crème glacée
- Ω Sacs ou contenants tubulaires de croustilles
- Ω Cartons et papiers cirés revêtus d'aluminium ou contrecollés.

RECYCLABLE PRODUCTS

- Plastic bags stuffed into a plastic bag
- Aluminum material such as clean pie plates or baking pans
- Newspapers and flyers
- Corrugated cardboard and packing boxes
- Magazines and catalogs
- Telephone directories
- Boxboard (cereal, shoes, detergent, etc.)
- Fine paper, such as writing paper, computer paper, notepaper, advertisements and books, hardcover and paperback
- Egg cartons, cardboard tubes from toilet paper or paper towels
- Wrapping paper, greeting cards, and paper grocery bags
- Metal cans from food or juices. Place lids in the can, closed and put loose in the box.
- Plastic containers from soft drinks, yogurt and margarine containers, and containers from liquid detergent, shampoo and cooking oil (remove all tops and lids)
- All other clean packaging paper
- Glass bottles and jars from food. Rinse and place loose in box.

PLEASE NOTE THAT:

- Small boxes can be deposited directly into the Blue Box
- Large boxes must be flattened and bundled into a maximum size of 1m x 1 m (36" x 36"), and placed beside the Blue Box
- Cardboard boxes will not be picked up with the regular garbage
- Newspapers and other recyclable papers can simply be placed in the Blue Box. If you have many, put the papers in a bag, preferably in a paper bag.
- Remove all stretch plastic wrapping material (plastic wrap around soft drink containers, etc.)

NON-RECYCLABLE PRODUCTS

- Ω Styrofoam containers
- Ω Aerosol cans and paint cans
- Ω Drink boxes, milk and juices cartons
- Ω Ceramic material, such as plates, cups and pottery
- Ω Other glass products, such as drinking glasses, window glass, light bulbs and mirrors
- Ω Other plastic material, such as dishes, toys, makeup containers, and caulking tubes
- Ω Frozen food containers that are waxed, such as concentrated juice containers, frozen meal containers, and ice cream containers
- Ω Chip bags or tube containers
- Ω Cardboard and paper that is waxed or lined with aluminum
